PANAMA WORKING GROUP SITUATION REPORT 0800 HOURS EDT OCTOBER 19, 1968

A CURFEW WAS AGAIN APPLIED IN PANAMA DURING THE NIGHT OCTOBER 18-19 AND. REPORTEDLY. CALM PREVAILED GENERALLY.

U. S. OFFICIALS HAVE CONTINUED TO CARRY ON CONVERSATIONS WITH ARNULFO ARIAS, IN AN EFFORT TO ARRANGE FOR HIS DEPARTURE FROM THE CANAL ZONE. STEPS HAVE BEEN TAKEN TO ASSURE THAT THE VARIOUS PANAMANIANS WHO ACCOMPANIED ARIAS INTO THE ZONE OR ENTERED IN RECENT DAYS ARE NOT ENGAGING IN POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. ADDITIONALLY, A PROGRAM DESIGNED TO EXTEND THE LIMITATIONS ON ARIAS' ACTIVITIES, EFFECTIVELY BUT INCONSPICUOUSLY, IS BEING CARRIED OUT. AT THE SAME TIME A SURFACE CORDIALITY BETWEEN HIM AND H. S. OFFICIALS IS BEING MAINTAINED.

FOLLOWING THE EFFORTS OF REPRESENTATIVES OF PANAMA'S PROVISIONAL GOVERNMENT . NTHE GOVERNMENTS OF NICARAGUA, HONDURAS AND EL SALVADOR HAVE CONFERRED AND HAVE GIVEN INDICATION THAT RECOGNITION WILL PROBABLY BE ACCORDED PANAMA'S JUNTA GOVERNMENT EARLY NEXT WEEK. SEVERAL OTHER GOVERNMENTS IN THE HEMISPHERE (ARGENTINA, BOLIVIA, ECUADOR, URUGUAY, BARBADOS) HAVE MADE IT CLEAR THAT THEY HAVE NOT YET FORMED A POSITION ON RECOGNITION AND THAT A DECISION IS NOT IMMINENT. THE PRESIDENT OF THE PANAMANIAN JUNTA HAS ANNOUNCED THAT ELECTIONS WILL BE HELD WITHIN A YEAR AND THAT, PRIOR TO THE NEXT ELECTIONS, ELECTORAL REFORMS ARE TO BE INSTITUTED; HE HAS SAID THAT A NEW ELECTORAL BOARD WILL BE NAMED WITHIN THE NEXT FEW DAYS AND THAT IT WILL SET A DATE FOR NEW ELECTIONS.
